Flammable liquids are vital on farms but pose major fire risks. This checklist outlines key setup and routine maintenance steps to keep people, equipment, and property safe.

1	Identify all liquids as flammable or combustible.	<input type="checkbox"/>
2	Store \leq 5 gallons in UL/FM safety cans.	<input type="checkbox"/>
3	Store larger amounts in approved cabinets (\leq 60 gal flammable / 120 gal combustible).	<input type="checkbox"/>
4	Place cabinets away from ignition sources.	<input type="checkbox"/>
5	Use dedicated storage room if $>$ 60 gallons indoors.	<input type="checkbox"/>
6	Designate indoor areas away from traffic/combustibles.	<input type="checkbox"/>
7	Keep outdoor storage away from buildings with hazard signage.	<input type="checkbox"/>
8	Ensure electrical wiring/fixtures meet NFPA 70.	<input type="checkbox"/>
9	Separate oxygen and fuel cylinders (20 ft or fire barrier).	<input type="checkbox"/>
10	Secure fuel cylinders upright with valves closed/caps on.	<input type="checkbox"/>
11	Store LP gas cylinders outdoors in locked racks/cages.	<input type="checkbox"/>
12	Confirm above-ground tanks meet NFPA/state rules.	<input type="checkbox"/>
13	Provide secondary containment for tanks.	<input type="checkbox"/>
14	Keep 25-ft clear zone around tanks.	<input type="checkbox"/>
15	Install bollards/fencing to prevent vehicle impact.	<input type="checkbox"/>
16	Post hazard signage and shut-off instructions near tanks.	<input type="checkbox"/>

Regular Maintenance Checks

Regular maintenance ensures that safe storage practices are sustained over time. Use this checklist for daily and periodic inspections to keep hazards under control.

1	Replace damaged or missing labels.	<input type="checkbox"/>
2	Keep liquids away from heaters, welders, engines.	<input type="checkbox"/>
3	Confirm ventilation (≥ 6 air changes/hour).	<input type="checkbox"/>
4	Inspect Class B extinguishers (sized, accessible, in date).	<input type="checkbox"/>
5	Ground and bond containers during transfer.	<input type="checkbox"/>
6	Check bonding wires/clamps are connected.	<input type="checkbox"/>
7	Store solvent rags in covered metal cans.	<input type="checkbox"/>
8	Empty solvent rag cans daily.	<input type="checkbox"/>
9	Remove empty or damaged containers.	<input type="checkbox"/>
10	Inspect containers for leaks, dents, or rust.	<input type="checkbox"/>
11	Keep lids tightly closed.	<input type="checkbox"/>
12	Ensure containers are not piling up.	<input type="checkbox"/>
13	Include storage checks in daily routines.	<input type="checkbox"/>
